Condo notes: Accommodations super. Lisa kept losing her shoes and clothes

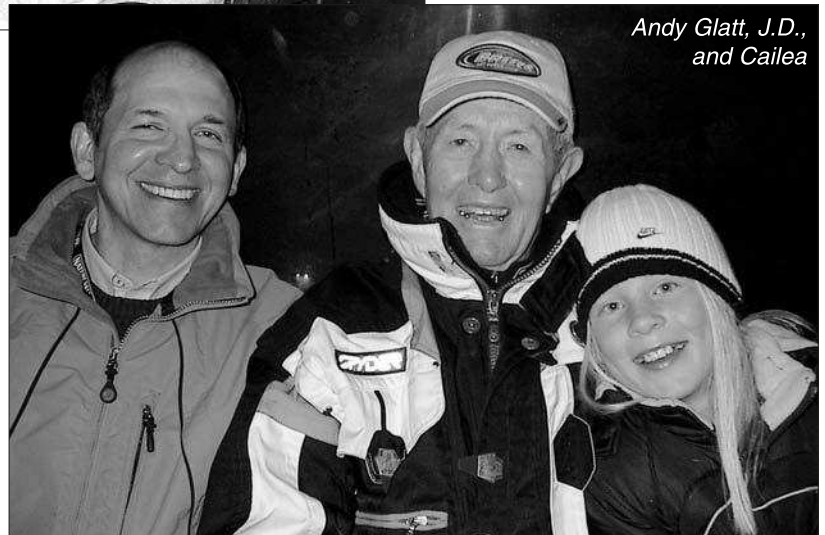
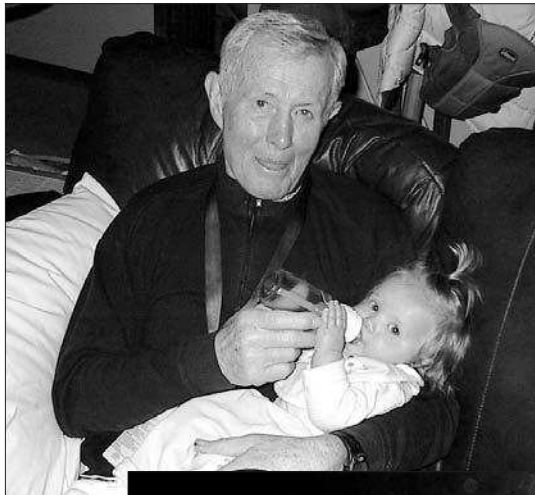
only to be found in my room. Eventually all was found and all was well. (Except the looks I got from everyone). I wonder what they were thinking?

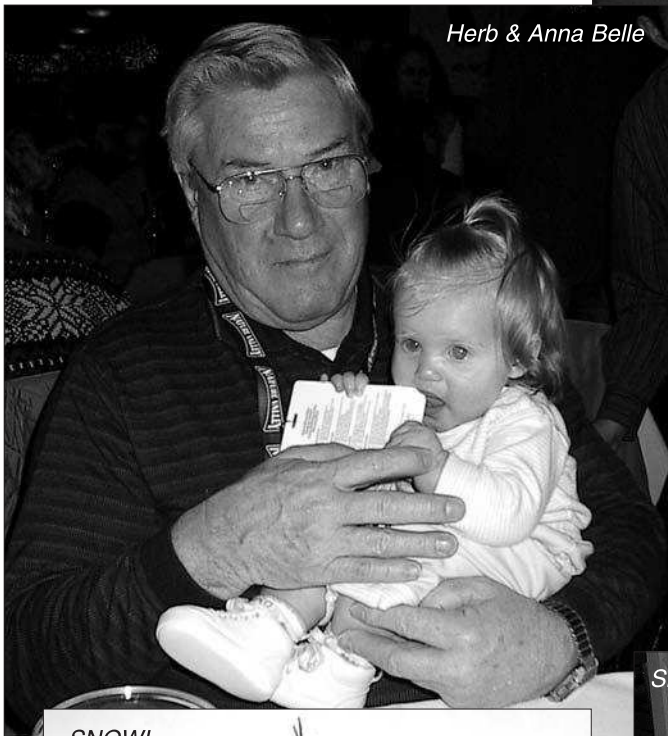

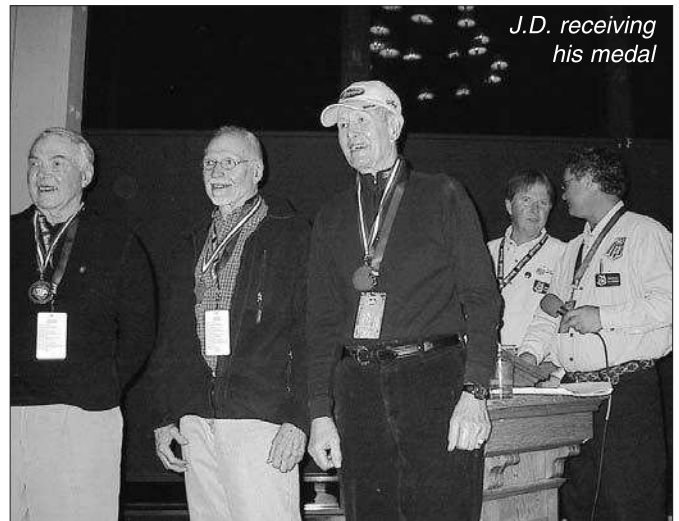
