Monthly Board Meeting

Trips – Lisa Warren explained and the board approved a trip discount policy that involves a four-day window for the Crested Butte trip and a two-week window for the Steamboat Springs trip. Deposits and payments must be made by the deadlines and no late registrants will be accepted. Both trips were priced based on a minimum of 20 participants for each trip. Membership dues must be current in order to take advantage of any discounts.

The following trip arrangements were approved:

Crested Butte (Dec. 9-13). Cost \$495 includes lift tickets. \$420 with discount if sign up at Sept. 21 Ski Club meeting (signup night) and pay \$50 deposit by Sept. 24. Trip captain: Lisa Warren.

Steamboat Springs (Jan. 25-31). Cost \$685 which includes activity pass (pass includes welcome party and awards banquet plus). \$610 with discount (no activity pass) and \$535 (with discount, no race, no activity). Signup is Sept. 21. Deposit of \$50 due Oct. 5 at SNO. Trip captain: John Clark.

Utah (Feb. 26-March 4). Cost \$650 for lodging. Minimum needed is 7 participants. Fly out. Trip coordinator: Lisa Warren.
